THE INSANITY OF THIS MOMENT:

"Today's wars are no longer just wars and clashes between armies but rather are struggles between societies. Let us be like a solid structure and play a game of biting fingers with the enemy, our society against their society."

I'm not here to convince you that World War 3 is happening, it is happening right now, and you should come to terms with that. What World War 3 means and will bring is only for us to find out. It isn't gonna be like World War 2, there is much more surveillance and technology now. I begin writing this analysis holed up in my room, isolating from a recent Covid exposure. Ukraine has just invaded Kursk and bombed a Russian nuclear power plant. Al Qassam Brigades members just executed a Zionist hostage in response to the uncountable massacres in Gaza. Iran, Yemen, and Hezbollah are all posed to retaliate to the American-Zionist assassinations at any day now. "America" has sent over 40,000 troops, multiple aircraft carriers, and even more arms to defend the Zionist colony from the Axis of Resistance's response. The outright, obvious genocide being inflicted on Gaza has continued for 10 months: Gaza has been transformed into the largest deathcamp in human history: over 200,000 Palestinians have been martyred by "Israel's" "Army". Al-Aqsa Mosque is being stormed by settlers again. The West Bank is back into Intifada. Imperialism ravages the Congo, Sudan, Syria, and the whole world. There are other fronts I can't even get into in this zine. "America" continues its internal genocide against Indigenous people of Turtle Island thru resource extraction, colonial domination, and concentration camp levels of isolation. Climate apocalypse looms over all of us. I can only hope to provide fierceness, clarity, analysis, and above all else: a call to action to readers about what is happening in front of us faster than we can comprehend. The future is not safe and it is not comfortable, not if we are to do anything about the war machine we find ourselves trapped in, and especially if we are to do the alternative of nothing at all. The enemy has never been more obvious, and yet it is all the easier to find ourselves drowned in paralysis, analysis, reformisms, "electoral politics", contradictions, and safety obsessed liberals. Negation, jouissance, and anarcho-nihilism provides much clarity in this clouded sea of distraction, confusion, and decadence.

"However, as we don't cage ourselves into demands and reformist notions, we maintain our characteristics and don't lose ourselves in petty political discounts to become socially "liked". Therefore, we invade as anarchists and don't hide behind other social masks (unemployed, worker, demonstrator); in contrast, we wear the hood and attack, without fearing the pit of contradictions of the intermediate struggles."

We are witnessing the Axis of Resistance deal a death of a million cuts to the Zionist colony right now. If you cannot see this, you have surrendered yourself to defeatism, or you aren't paying attention. Yes, there is an unimaginable genocide being inflicted on the Palestinians, but do not think for a second that Israel will find victory. *Can the American colony not also die the same death?* Is it the large hoarded landmass that makes it hard to imagine? Is it our speculatively and artificially inflated economy? Is it the privilege "Americans" have? Is it the armed force and violence inflicted on those who oppose this settler colony? Is it the military?



IN THEIR HANDS:

Regardless of how difficult it may or may not be to imagine this future, the act of a singular cut against a settler colony in the context of an individual life should be seen as something beautiful and admirable, we have to be realistic with what we can do, and we should strive after it. Resistance operations in the West Bank, Hamas ambushes in Gaza: fighters who have stayed steadfast and stationary for 8 months to detonate buried explosives on armored vehicles, molotov cocktails and rocks thrown by Palestinian youth, drones sent from Yemen and Iraq to target energy infrastructure, security targets, and shipping, industrial sabotage of weapons and drone factories in the West, arson attacks against Cop Cities, destruction of security cameras anywhere, Hezbollah's deterrence equations, Iranian psychological warfare, Jordanians blocking supply lines to Israel, the few Egyptian soldiers who have resisted and died at the Rafah border, and even Haredi Jews overrunning "IDF" military bases to protest that they are being drafted. This list is not exhaustive. Many of the people who have participated in these acts have been killed or imprisoned, and may not be able to ever witness the fruition of their actions, but that has no bearing on the massive amount of cuts that the Zionist colony has accumulated: all that counts is that the Zionist colony was cut. It is not a coincidence that many of these people are putting their lives second to their causes. It is not a coincidence that being a martyr, or a shaheed in the Islamic world means someone who died while witnessing injustice. I don't want to pretend to know all of the cultural connotations of martyrdom. When it comes down to helping Palestinians, one of the few things that has made any difference is principled, armed resistance. Should that not be a guide to us?

We live in one of the largest war machines to ever exist. Don't you notice the cogs starting to spin faster and faster? Don't you see the sacred life being crushed and torn between these cogs? Don't you want to watch these cogs screech to a fucking halt? How can we slow these cogs without engaging in saviorism? What will clog them down the most? *Near where I live, there is an offshore wind factory farm being planned and developed.* I don't know all the details, but I don't need to know details to know that the energy that would be produced by this farm would be used to offset fossil fuels, specifically to make them more available to enable state sanctioned slaughter somewhere, especially when wartime gas rationing inevitably begins. This war machine cannot be allowed to continue, and those inside the war machine have a unique role to play against it. "Green" energy is just more wartime infrastructure. More killings, more desecrations, more pollution and more violations of the earth itself. More starvation and more siege tactics used against people who have already endured the impossible. Do you really think societal progress is worth this?

"What the fuck are we supposed to do?" First off, read some FAI, IRF, or Conspiracy Cells of Fire texts. Like seriously, read it and understand it. You are an autonomous individual. Start with *Communization: The Senile Decay of Anarchy*, and read *Lone Wolves are Not Alone* next. The conditions for revolution will never come, it is a dead end thought that only postpones. Your life and your "safety" is not more important than what you believe if you decide it to be so, you just have to be willing to make that choice. The moment will never be more right than right now. The best thing we can do to be in solidarity with Palestinians is to utterly and absolutely attack (from the inside) at the war machine that is killing them, which is "America" - which is "The West" - which is "Israel". There is no reforming "America" out of genocide, it has been inbuilt in this project since its inception. The propaganda of autonomous anarchist attack rises above all other forms.

Do not forget your ability to make a choice.

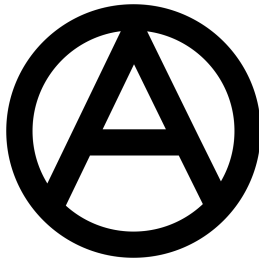

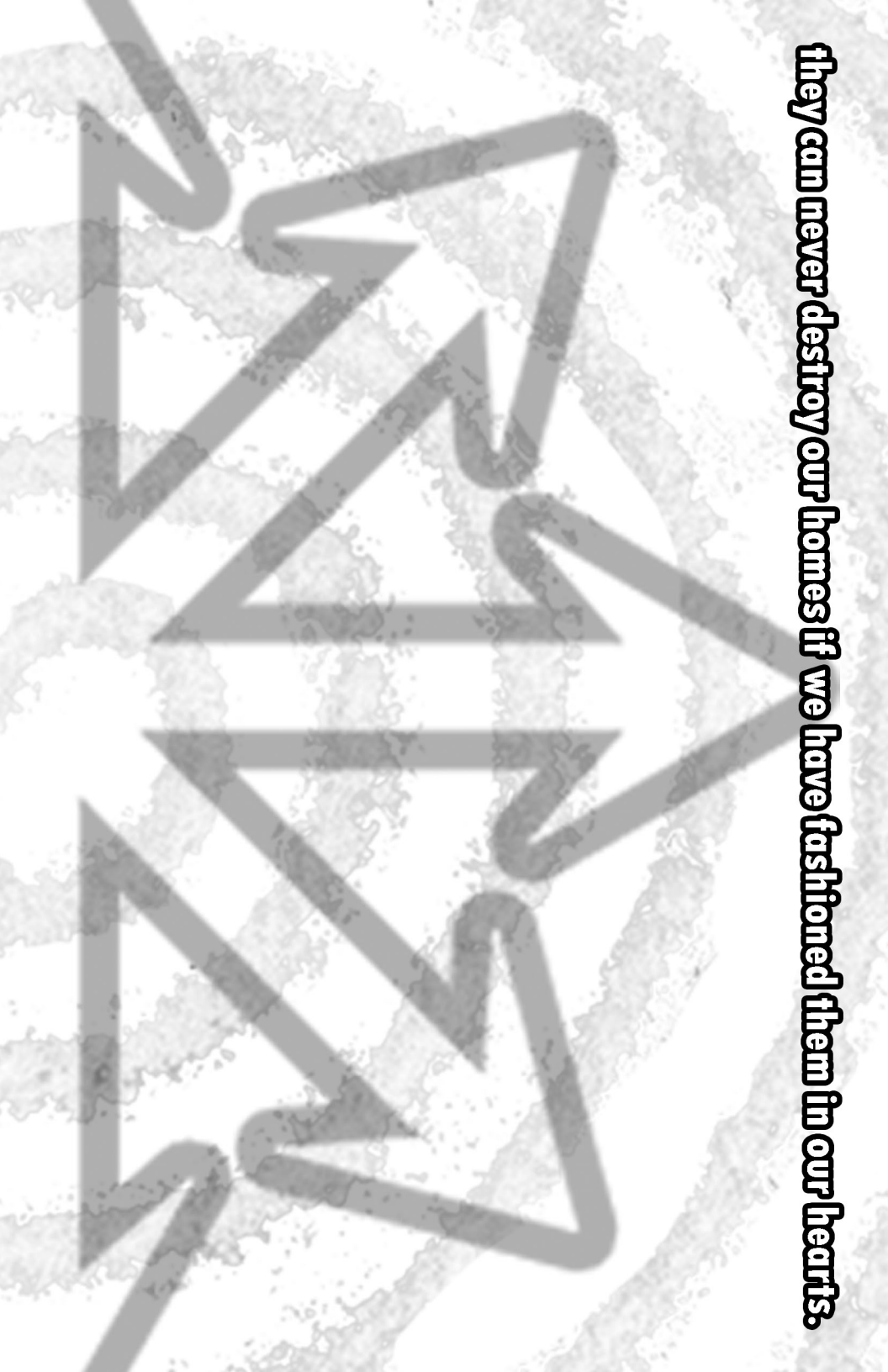
"Greetings of Arab nationalism, homeland, and liberation,
